With this in mind, the Rotary Club of Kuching Central has joint forces with the Royal Malaysian Police, Sarawak Contigent, to hold a one hour 'Crime Prevention Awareness' talk on 29 January 2005 to be held at the SUPP Convention Hall at Jalan Tan Sri Ong Kee Hui, Kuching.

The event will be graced by YB. Dato Seri Abang Hj Abdul Rahman Zohari bin Tun Abang Hj Openg, State Minister of Housing. Sarawak Deputy Police Commissioner, SAC 1 Abang Abdul Wahap Bin Abang Hj Julai will be the speaker.

The activity is organized under the 'Service for New Generations' portfolio in the Rotary Club of Kuching Central and is headed by the Past President Frankie Yang.

An estimated 1,000 students from 25 schools in Kuching will be attending the talk. The co-organisers are the Rotaract Club of Swinburne University, Interact Clubs of SMK Bandar Kuching No. 1 and Kuching High.
