
Rotary charity run set for Feb 26

One current project is the provision of solar lighting system for rural longhouses and communities in Kanowit and Bintulu areas.

RCKC also works in collaboration with the Ministry of Health's Ophthalmology Department to conduct cataract remedy/operations for lower-income groups in the rural areas.

Another major ongoing programme provides school kits for selected students from poor families in both urban and rural communities.

Registration fees for the charity run are RM50 for 2 and 5km categories and RM80 for 8km.
