FOURTH

The advancement of international understanding, goodwill and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

ROTARY HISTORY

A Brief History

The world's first service club, the Rotary Club of Chicago, Illinois, USA, was formed on 23 February 1905 by Paul P. Harris, an attorney who wished to recapture in a professional club the same friendly spirit he had felt in the small towns of his youth. The name "Rotary" derived from the early practice of rotating meetings among members' offices.

Rotary's popularity spread throughout the United States in the decade that followed; clubs were chartered from San Francisco to New York. By 1921, Rotary clubs had been formed on six continents, and the organization adopted the name Rotary International a year later.

As Rotary grew, its mission expanded beyond serving the professional and social interests of club members. Rotarians began pooling their resources and contributing their talents to help serve communities in need. The organization's dedication to this ideal is best expressed in its principal motto: Service Above Self. Rotary also later embraced a code of ethics, called The 4-Way Test, that has been translated into hundreds of languages.

During and after World War II, Rotarians became increasingly involved in promoting international understanding. A Rotary conference held in London in 1942 planted the seeds for the development of the United Nations Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization (UNESCO), and numerous Rotarians have served as consultants to the United Nations.

An endowment fund, set up by Rotarians in 1917 "for doing good in the world," became a not-for-profit corporation known as The Rotary Foundation in 1928. Upon the death of Paul Harris in 1947, an outpouring of Rotarian donations made in his honor, totaling US\$2 million, launched the Foundation's first program — graduate fellowships, now called Ambassadorial Scholarships. Today, contributions to The Rotary Foundation total more than US\$80 million annually and support a wide range of humanitarian grants and educational programs that enable Rotarians to bring hope and promote international understanding throughout the world.

In 1985, Rotary made a historic commitment to immunize all of the world's children against polio. Working in partnership with nongovernmental organizations and national governments through its PolioPlus program, Rotary is the largest private-sector contributor to the global polio eradication campaign. Rotarians have mobilized hundreds of thousands of PolioPlus volunteers and have immunized more than one billion children worldwide. By the 2005 target date for certification of a polio-free world, Rotary will have contributed half a billion dollars to the cause.

As it approached the dawn of the 21st century, Rotary worked to meet the changing needs of society, expanding its service effort to address such pressing issues as environmental degradation, illiteracy, world hunger, and children at risk. The organization admitted women for the first time (worldwide) in 1989 and claims more than 90,000 women in its ranks today. Following the collapse of the Berlin Wall and the dissolution of the Soviet Union, Rotary clubs were formed or re-established throughout Central and Eastern Europe. Today, 1,216,968 million Rotarians belong to some 32,814 Rotary clubs in more than 166 countries.

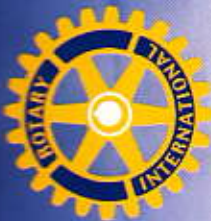



KUCHING: The Cardiac Centre of the Sarawak General Hospital (SGH) received the Vocation Service Award from the Rotary Club of Kuching Central (RCKC) in a simple ceremony held here yesterday.

According to its president, Leslie Phuan, the award was presented to the centre for its exemplary outstanding professional achievement while maintaining very high ethical standards in the delivery of services especially to those where such services are beyond their economic reach.

On the same note, director of vocational service, Rotarian Andrew Chong, further explained that the award was an annual award given to individuals whereas this year, the bulk of the club decided to give the award to a whole department.

"We decided to give the award to the department collectively because everyone in the Cardiac Centre within

the department has performed his or her job beyond the call of duty with so much dedication and passion. The vocation, doctor and nursing staff are truly professional, ethical and also very warm and friendly," said Chong.

He explained that the Rotary Vocational Service awards signify the adherence and promotion of the highest ethical standards in all occupations, including for treatment of employers, employees, associates and the public; the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations and contribution of the vocational talents to solving the problems of society and meeting needs of the community.

"The centre also caters to patients after treatment to check on them and this makes follow-up services provided by the Cardiac Centre in the SGH as second to none."

Club to hold 'Avoidable Blindness' project

KUCHING: Rotary Club of Kuching Central will conduct the second phase of its 'Avoidable Blindness' project sometime in July or August of this year.

According to the project's organising chairman, Andre Salama, 38 people were detected to have advanced cataracts when they did the first project in November last year.

"We plan to perform the cataract operations this year and at the same time screen those who did not have the opportunity the last time, he said at the close of 'Avoidable Blindness' project in Kaps' here yesterday.

He said the next project, to cost them about RM20,000, would also involve the provision of free spectacles to the patients. Kapsi Member of

Parliament Alexander Nanta Lagan, Sarawak Director Dr Andrew Kiju, Sarawak General Hospital's Ophthalmology unit consultant Dr Juan Gaden, eye specialist Dr Malika, Provincial and Rotary Club president Leslie Phuan were also present.

A total of 631 patients were screened over two days at Meljai Hotel in Kapsi during the first project. Of the number, 38 were found to have advanced cataracts, 13 immature cataracts, 53 placed for referrals, 100 needed ready-made reading glasses, 160 needed custom-made spectacles, and 209 others were fine.

Alexander, in his speech, recalled that Rotary Club for its efforts in carrying out such projects for the people with eye

problems.

He said when it came down to welfare, the people's health mattered most, and said the many people from the internet coming down to have their eyes screened touched him.

Dr Kiju who also spoke said there was a need to tackle the main areas like education and prevention besides the curative aspects of eye care.

He said the Health Department would want to see the 'Rotary' club and other associations involved in health projects, to sustain what they were doing by conducting follow-ups.

He said the department was supportive of such project but said any project to be conducted should have scientific evidence to back

them up.

He said it would be hard to support projects that bring in, he said, a professor from China to talk about antibodies that can cure cancer," he said.

Dr Kiju also said although the department would like to get involved in many projects such as this, it could only do so to a certain extent given the manpower constraint.

Nevertheless, he said he was pleased to note the success of the 'Avoidable Blindness' project in Kapsi and hoped that more of such projects would be done in the State's interior in the future.

The event culminated with the presentation of appreciation plaques and certificates to those involved in the project.
