

Manga Klaasen is a 3-hour drive from luching in a remote rural area. The school has 130 students. Eighty percent of the student live in dormitories because their houses are too far away. The residence officer from Sri Aman contacted PP Chieng Lee Ching and asked for help. After the needs had been identified and funds was missed the club made a commitment to help with 27 bicycles, de-worming and was screening.


