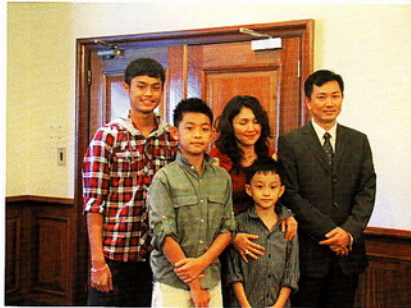

#### The goals of the workshop are:

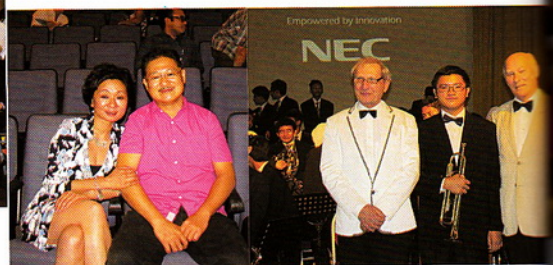
Enabling an exchange of skills and experiences between the musical directors of the respective bands.

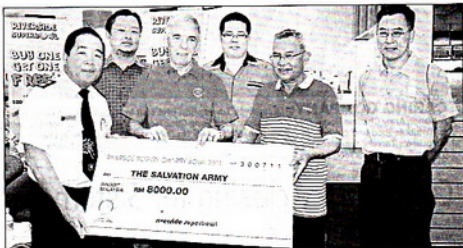

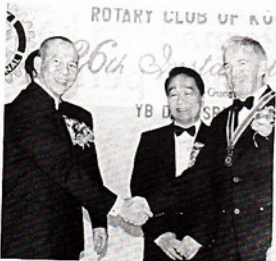
