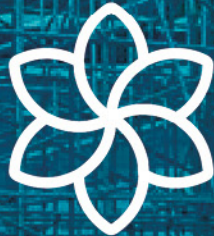

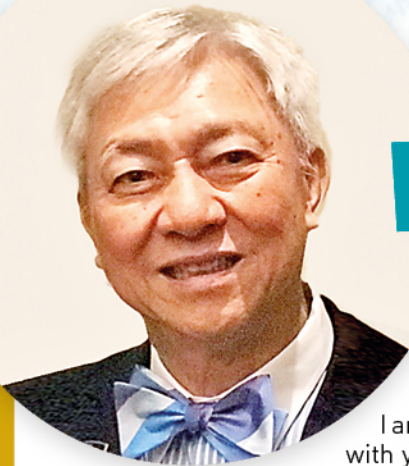

Time flies when you're having fun, especially with a group of people with the common interest to serve humanity. As a young president to the club, I must admit that leading a well-established club is not an easy task. It has been an eventful year and 2017-18's theme, 'Making A Difference' brought our club to embark on new projects this Rotary year. I strongly believe in these projects which are more sustainable, as the beneficiaries will bring more value to their surrounding people in near future.

With the help of the Rotaract Club of Swinburne Sarawak, Interact Club of Bukit Gombak Eagles Singapore, and Rotary Club of Singapore, and the Swinburne University Library, we managed to implement our first Literacy project in recent years by providing 2700 books to the libraries of 3 primary schools in Serian and Kuching. Due to the strong publicity we have done since beginning of the year, our club was also able to collaborate with apparel company UNIQLO to organise the 'Clothes of Love' project for the hardcore poor of Bau to 'shop' from a collection of pre-loved clothes.

Apart from the abovementioned, we also further enhanced our signature cataract project 'Rotary Brings Vision' together with CIMB Foundation Community Link to assist more beneficiaries in Sarawak than in the previous year. Therefore, we have scheduled cataract operations until the end of 2018. Our 'Back to School' project with Yayasan Sime Darby had also expanded to Bintulu with more beneficiaries receiving school kits. Additionally, we continued our relationship with the Church of Latter Day Saints through which we were able to repair and enhance the outdoor activity area of the special needs students of SJK Bintawa. A big salute to our strong supporters throughout these past years and I hope that we can continue and strengthen these relationships to have even bigger projects than ever, with significant impacts.

The Rotary Charity Run 2018 – Gift of Sight, was successfully organised by our Incoming President Jong Kiam Ngee and it won the Best Project with PR content for our District 3310. Through the effort of PP Dato Thomas Ngu and his team, we managed to raise RM380,000 in cash & kind, which is also the largest fund we have ever raised in our account's history. Rest assured that all the funds raised will solely be used for our club's signature cataract and prevention of blindness project. Our club is in the midst of identifying the most effective way to implement the raised funds to assist more deserving members of the community afflicted with cataracts. Besides sustaining our relationship with KK1M, we are eager to see how we can work together with the private medical sector to bring vision back for cataract patients and help even more people to prevent blindness.

Beside this, RCKC has been awarded the Rotary International Citation 2017-18 through all the activities and projects carried out. We have also inducted 4 new members this year, thus achieving the 50 members' milestone, with 2 new members being young and energetic under 40 year olds. I am sure with the help of our new members and their expertise, our club will be able to extend our hand to a wider range of people with new projects. Hopefully the efforts of our club's champion of service projects PP Louis Yong can set a good example to all Rotarians that actions speak louder than words, with his quick response to community needs, especially in rural areas.

Through the leadership of our Youth Chair PP Ng Yaw Hua, I am proud to announce that all five of our sponsored Interact clubs and both Rotaract clubs achieved Rotary International Citation 2017-18 as well. Special thanks to all the Rotarians advisers, Teacher/Lecturer advisers, and institutions for their support and dedication towards the clubs and our community.

I am immensely grateful for Rtn Andrea Chan who has worked tirelessly throughout the 12 months and even before the Rotary year began. I would say she is more like my Personal Assistant who helped me arrange everything that we have discussed for the club, and made sure everything is in order. She definitely deserved to win the District 3310 Most Outstanding Young Rotarian award.

I would also like to express my gratitude to IPDG Datuk Lee Chuen Wan and his spouse Datuk Naomi for their constant presence at our club activities despite their busy schedule. Rotary brings together a global network of volunteers who dedicate their time and talent to tackle the world's most pressing humanitarian challenges. Rotary connects 1.2 million members from more than 200 countries and geographical areas. Their work impacts lives at both the local and international levels, from helping families in need in their own communities to working toward a polio-free world. Rotary also offers expanded service opportunities through the Family of Rotary with the latest statistics as below:

Membership Snapshot

Who: Rotary brings together the kind of people who step forward to take on important issues for local communities worldwide. Rotary members hail from a range of professional backgrounds; doctors, artists, small business owners and executives all call themselves Rotarians. Rotary connects these unique perspectives, and helps leverage its members' expertise to improve lives everywhere.

Where: From Haiti and Greenland to Nigeria and Singapore, Rotary unites a truly diverse set of leaders from across the world. Currently, the largest number of clubs comes from the United States, India, Japan and Brazil. The fastest growing Rotary regions include Southeast Asia and Africa.

What: Rotarians contribute their time, energy and passion to sustainable, long-term projects in local communities across the globe. Projects focus on important issues like peace and conflict resolution, disease prevention and treatment, water and sanitation, maternal and child health, basic education and literacy and economic and community development.



Polio

Poliomyelitis (polio) is a paralyzing and potentially fatal disease that still threatens children in some parts of the world. The poliovirus invades the nervous system and can cause total paralysis in a matter of hours. It can strike at any age but mainly affects

children under five. Polio is incurable, but completely vaccine-preventable.

PolioPlus

In 1985, Rotary launched its PolioPlus program, the first initiative to tackle global polio eradication through the mass vaccination of children. Rotary has contributed more than \$1.7 billion and countless volunteer hours to immunize more than 2.5 billion children in 122 countries. In addition, Rotary's advocacy efforts have played a role in decisions by donor governments to contribute more than \$7.2 billion to the effort.

Global Polio Eradication Initiative

The Global Polio Eradication Initiative, formed in 1988, is a public-private partnership that includes Rotary, the World Health Organization, the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, UNICEF, the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, and governments of the world. Rotary's focus is advocacy, fundraising, volunteer recruitment and awareness-building.

Polio Today

Today, there are only three countries that have never stopped transmission of the wild poliovirus: Afghanistan, Nigeria and Pakistan. Just 37 polio cases were confirmed worldwide in 2016, which is a reduction of more than 99.9 percent since the 1980s, when the world saw about 1,000 cases per day.

Challenges

The polio cases represented by the remaining one percent are the most difficult to prevent, due to factors including geographical isolation, poor public infrastructure, armed conflict and cultural barriers. Until polio is eradicated, all countries remain at risk of outbreaks.

Ensuring Success

Rotary will raise \$50 million per year over the next three years, with every dollar to be matched with two additional dollars from the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation. These funds help to provide much-needed operational support, medical personnel, laboratory equipment, and educational materials for health workers and parents. Governments, corporations and private individuals all play a crucial role in funding.

Rotary in Action

More than one million Rotary members have donated their time and personal resources to end polio. Every year, hundreds of Rotary members work side-by-side with health workers to vaccinate children in polio-affected countries. Rotary Members work with UNICEF and other partners to prepare and distribute mass communication tools to reach people in areas isolated by conflict, geography, or poverty. Rotary members also recruit fellow volunteers, assist with transporting the vaccine, and provide other logistical support.

'This Close' Campaign

Rotary has a growing roster of public figures and celebrities participating in its "This Close" public awareness campaign, including Bill Gates, co-chair of the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation; actresses Kristen Bell and Archie Panjabi; WWE superstar John Cena; supermodel Isabeli Fontana; Nobel Peace Prize laureate Archbishop Emeritus Desmond Tutu; action movie star Jackie Chan; boxing great Manny Pacquiao; pop star Psy; golf legend Jack Nicklaus; conservationist Jane Goodall; premier violinist Itzhak Perlman; Grammy Award winners A.R. Rahman; Angélique Kidjo and Ziggy Marley; and peace advocate Queen Noor of Jordan. These ambassadors help educate the public about polio through public service announcements, social media and public appearances.

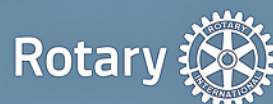
