

Outgoing President 2018-2019

Time flies. It is time for me to present my final remarks after a year as President. It was a privilege to serve as the 33rd President of RCKC which is one of the most Vibrant and Active Club in our District, encapsulating all that Rotary represents. Hui Na and I really enjoyed ourselves, especially with the strong support and participation from our members and spouses.

Rotary year 2018-19 theme "Be The Inspiration", has inspired me to undertake numerous activities and projects in this past Rotary year. Our Board of Directors, Service Avenues Chairs and their Committees have stepped up and served with distinction. I could not have wished for a better team.

Our Club's signature project, Prevention of Blindness 2018-19, in collaboration with Klinik Kataract Kementerian Kesihatan Malaysia (KKKKM) for the 7th year, has continued its outreach to help the underprivileged in our rural communities for Cataract remedy operations. We jointly helped 302 cataract patients restored their vision this Rotary year. My sincere thanks to our funding partners, CIMB Community Link Foundation and Sponsors of our Gift of Sight Charity Run 2018. In addition, we also provided 80 pieces of Intra Ocular Lens for the 'Urban Poor Program' to Ophthalmology Department, Sarawak General Hospital. RCKC also donated a unit of AutoClave equipment to KKKKM to facilitate its operations.

Under our focus on WASH (Water, Sanitation and Hygiene); RCKC installed Water Filter System at SK Lubok Buntin, Simunjan as well as rebuilt their washroom and washing facilities, renovated and upgraded the washroom facilities at SK Chung Hua Siburan and SK St. Teresa, Serian with funding from HSBC Bank. RCKC also carried out repairing and upgrading works for students' washroom at SK St. Alban, Kuching. Additionally, RCKC partnered with LDS Charities to build new washroom facilities in SK Bedup, Serian. Thank you HSBC Bank, LDS Charities and all our sponsors for funding these projects which have brought significant and meaningful long lasting benefits to our rural youths.

For Back to School 2019, RCKC collaborated with Yayasan Sime Darby for a second year to provide school bags. stationaries, school uniform, shoes, and socks to more than 900 students in 5 primary schools in Bintulu and 2 primary schools in Sibu, and we also partnered with RC Penang and our sister club RC Taipei Golden Eagle to give similar school kits to more than 300 Students in 4 primary schools in Kuching. These properly dressed rural students now proudly carry bags with the Rotary logo to school every day.

Our Community Service Projects included participating in charity sales for Kuching Autistic Association, Salvation Army, Wishesland and PERKATA to assist them in raising funds for their operations. We also distributed food parcels to 33 hard-core poor households in both urban and suburban Kuching during festive seasons.

RCKC continues to be prominently active in our Youth Service Projects. We organised the Regional Youth Leadership Training for Interactors and Rotaractors in Sarawak to provide them with the tools and knowledge to lead their clubs. RCKC also organized the 4th Regional I-Quiz Sarawak 2018 in collaboration with D3300 RC Bandar Sunway and provided funds for the winning team to participate in the Grand Finals held in Bandar Sunway College in Kuala Lumpur. The 3 member team of Lodge International School, supervised by a teacher, emerged as the National Champion, a first time for a school outside of Klang Valley.

RCKC also held the Rotary Youth Leadership Award (RYLA) 2018 Kuching at SMK Gapor Kuching from 7th to 9th December, Organising Chair Rtn Roland Phang and his committee successfully gathered trainers and facilitators to develop leadership skills and teamwork for the participants from throughout Sarawak.

In addition, RCKC was tasked by District Governor 2018-19 Henry Tan to organize the 30th Pan Borneo Meet 2018 from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> November 2018 in Kuching. A total of 350 participants from 52 clubs throughout Districts 3300 and 3310 attended this Meet. Prominent speakers were sourced to enlighten delegates who also enjoyed great fellowship and camaraderie. A joint Community Project with the collaboration of all 28 Rotary Clubs in Borneo and a number of individual Rotarian sponsors installed 13 sturdy belian wood benches at Kuching Waterfront to provide comfortable resting facilities to the numerous visitors who frequent this tourist area. The Rotary Masterbrand Signature is highly visible on all benches to publicise Rotary. Congratulations and well done to the Organizing Chair PP Thomas Ngu and your committee for the success of Pan Borneo Meet 2018.

RCKC collaborated with District Action Group on Autism (DAGA) from District 3300 for a workshop on Early Intervention on Austism on 10th November 2018. The workshop, attended by a full capacity of 40 caregivers parents and teachers, educated them in proper care for autistic persons. Well done PP Leslie Phuan as the OC for this project.

The Rotary Foundation Seminar 2018 for Sarawak clubs was organized by RCKC on 20th of October 2018 at The Waterfront Hotel, Several informative sessions were conducted by PDG Michael Yee, PDG Philip Chong and PP Ng Yaw Hua. We are pleased that DG Henry Tan graced the event with his presence. Well done to Rtn Tiong Khai as OC for this seminar.

Rotary Charity Bowling Tournament 2019 was held at Riverside Superbowl on 20th January 2019 with the principal aim of raising funds for our Club projects. This annual charity event attracted participants from Rotary Families, Corporates and friends of Rotary. Thank you OC PP Aw Tai Hui and your Committee for raising RM21, 000 to facilitate our Club projects.



For International Service, RCKC participated in the "Help The Children" project with RC Singapore in Malang, Indonesia from 12- 14th Oct 2018. On 10th - 13th January 2019, RCKC also participated in Smile Cambodia Cleft Lips Project with RC Likas Bay.

RCKC celebrated World Peace and Understanding Day together with other Rotary Clubs in Kuching on 23th February 2019. Several activities and seminars were held at CityONE Megamall during the day to highlight Rotary projects to the general public with an International Night celebration in the evening. We thank AG Wilson Tan for fostering better relationship among our 5 Kuching Clubs.

Rotary Charity Run 2019 was carried out on 7th April 2019 at CityONE Megamall Kuching. The OC was PE Leonard Sia and we were privileged to have YB Dato' Sri Nancy Binti Shukri as our Guest of Honour together with Special Guest DG Henry Tan to grace this event. A total of 1600 participants registered for the run. We wish to thank all the participants and our sponsors for generously supporting this annual Rotary Run.

Our Club is well known as a family oriented Club with spouses and Rotarians' children actively participating in our fellowship activities. This year, in addition to our annual activities and festive celebrations, we organised an overnight outing for our members, spouses & children. Jungle Tracking, obstacles course, lessons on how to build fire are among the interesting activities we pursued during the 2 days outing.

We went on a vocational visit to Biodiversity Centre to together with our members & families and were joined by several of our Rotaractors. Speakers were also invited regularly to our Club meetings to provide insights into their field of expertise.

Rotary has been working to eradicate polio for more than 30 years. Our goal of ridding the world of this disease is closer than ever. As a founding partner of the Global Polio Eradication Initiative, we have reduced polio cases by 99.9 percent since our first project to vaccinate children in the Philippine in 1979

We have helped immunize more than 2.5 billion children in 122 countries. So far, Rotary has contributed more than \$1.8 billion toward eradicating the disease worldwide.

Today, polio remains endemic only in Afghanistan, Nigeria, and Pakistan. But it's crucial to continue working to keep other countries polio-free. If all eradication efforts stopped today, within 10 years, polio could paralyze as many as 200,000 children each year.






