The test, which has been translated in more than 100 languages, ask the following questions of all the things we think, say or do:

- Is if the TRUTH?
- 2. Is it FAIR to all concerned?
- 3. Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
  - 4. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?

### ROTARY AND UNICEF

The greatest example of Ratany's effective collaborations is if lagship program. Polio Plus, which aims to eracticate polio worldwide. Working with spearheading partner UNICEF, the U.S. Centers of Disease Control and Prevention, and the World Health Organization, Rotany has contributed over US&Boot million and countless volunteer hours to help immunize more than two billion children against the crippling and often folial disease.

Bills and Melinda Gates Foundation has awarded Rotary USD355 million to support its effort to eradicate polio. In respond, Rotary has committed to raise USD200 million by 30th June 2012. As of this month, Rotary has raised about USD130 million.

### ROTARY AND UNITED NATIONS

Rotary and United nations have a long history of working together and sharing similar visions for a more peaceful world.

In 1942, clubs from 21 nations organized a conference in London to develop a

vision for advancing education, science, and culture after World Wor II. That event was a precursor to UNESCO. In 1945, 49 Rotarians went to San Francisco to help draft the UN Charter. Rotary and UN have been close partners ever since, a relationship that's apparent through Polic Plus and work with UN agencies.
