SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF 'ROTARY BRINGS VISION & HEALTH TO THE PEOPLE OF BARIO' PROJECT 22nd-24th JANUARY 2010

A total of 410 people had their eyes and health checked by a team of medical personnel in the remote Bario Highlands, Sarawak, Malaysia. The project was organized by the Rotary Club of Kuching Central. Of the 410 people, 72.4% were students of primary and secondary schools while the rest were the adult members of the community.



The team comprising of 16 medical personnel and members of the Rotary Club of Kuching Central arrived in Bario on Friday morning, 22 January 2010 led by the club Presider Thomas Ngu. Upon arrived, the team screened 144 primary school students followed by 153 secondary school students. Each student was given a de-worning tablet before their eyes were screened. A total of 24 pairs of specacles were prescribed to the students.

The following day was dedicated wholly for the adult members of the Bario community where the team commenced their operations from 7:30am until 3pm. A total of 113 adults had their eyes and health checked. This included a measure of their height and body weight followed by a check of their blood pressure and suzur level.



With the co-operations & assistance of the members of Klinik Kesihaan Bario, we were able to have advance registration of patients one week before the team arrived in Bario. This helped the organizing committee in determining the amount of medications, resources and spectacles to bring to Bario. Much publicity was carried out for this project with the printing and distribution of flyers containing information about the project. Some of the flyers were put up at the Bario airport notice board, Bario towe center and schools.





"The 16 project team members comprised or optometrists," medical doctors and 2 ophthalmologists and members of the Rotary Club of Kuching Central. Of the 10 medical personnel, 1 optometrist and 2 medical doctors are members of the Rotary Club of Kuching Central. The third doctor was the president of the Rotary Club of Mrit, who is a surgeon attacked to the Miri General Hospital," said Andre Saharto.
